

**Pig Trail Chapter Northwest Arkansas
Harley-Davidson HOG Chapter #2075
Chapter Meeting Minutes
Saturday, April 6, 2019**

- Call to Order – Trey Hargus called the meeting to order at 9:32 AM. The sign-in showed 109 people in attendance.
- Pledge to Flag – Trey lead the Pledge with Channel 5 present and recording.
- Dealership Topics – Floyd announced that clean trades will be valued at 110% of NADA on 2016 and older bikes when trading for a new bike, he also recommended that members ask if they are on the “equity list” when dealing on a new bike. Melody drew a ticket from all who rode bikes to the meeting and Kelly Cunningham won a thermal cooler bag, she recognized the models for the garage party and presented them with a gift, she announced that the dealership has a swap meet scheduled for next week and they are donating two spaces for HOG members to sell their goods, Travis Cave won the drawing for the 1st quarter attendance award. Matt announced that the next Pig Trail University will focus on illumination, motor clothes will promote “see and be seen” clothing, today’s flash sale will be 15% off on H-D luggage and LED lighting, also 15% cash back on all parts and labor, voting will commence on April 15th for the “battle of the kings” bike with more details to come.
- Celebrations and Sharing – Royce Barnes roved about the room recognizing many members who were celebrating anniversaries and birthdays, he also recognized Mitch Stewart, Michelle Conway, and Garry Raymond for their recent purchases of 2019 bikes.

Membership/Introductions of New Members and Guests – Stacey Ann Wollman introduced new members Jimmy & Traci Easter, Kelly Cunningham, Bill Harrison, and Jeff & Tami Clark. Deb Raymond won a cocktail set in the membership drawing. Stacey Ann discussed the new membership recruitment cards and encouraged members to turn them in for a drawing to be held at the Christmas Party, and she also announced the new policy that the HOG Chapter will grant a one-year complementary membership to any non-member who purchases a Harley-Davison motorcycle.

- Volunteers Needed for Sub-committees– Trey announced two new opportunities for members to volunteer to serve on sub committees.
 - Communication – Jeffrey Bushey announced a need for help with the Facebook page, the website, and the newsletter.
 - Merchandise – Garry Raymond commended David Patterson and Troy Adams for their excellent work in constructing the display case at the membership kiosk, he is seeking some members to be “Merch Coordinators” to organize and stock the display with chapter items for sale.
